

I Have NOOK & I Want to Download Free E-Books from the Library

What do I need to download E-books onto my Nook from the Rampart Library District?

- You need a Rampart Library District **Resident** card in good standing.
- **For Nook Color/Tablet users:** Overdrive Media Console App downloaded onto your device through your App Store
- **For all other Nooks:** A home computer or laptop with Adobe Digital Editions installed.

Download & Transfer Instructions:

Step 1: Download required free software.

For Nook Color/Tablet users: Download the Overdrive Media Console App

- In the App, click the “=” button towards the bottom of the screen
- Select ‘Get Books’
- Type ‘Marmot Library Network’
- Enter your library card number (numbers only - no spaces)
- Select ‘Marmot OverDrive Digital Collection’
- Start browsing! You’re done!

For all other Nook users:

Overdrive eBooks for older Nooks are in Adobe EPUB and Adobe PDF formats and work with Adobe Digital Editions software. You **MUST** download this free software onto your computer.

- Go to <http://rampart.colibraries.org>
- On the left-hand side menu, click ‘eContent’
- Click ‘Overdrive’ until...
- You will be brought to the ‘Marmot OverDrive Digital Collection’ page. Click on the ‘Help’ icon at the top of the page.
- Click on ‘Software’
- Click on ‘Adobe Digital Editions’. This takes you to a new webpage – download and install the software.
- Activate the Adobe Digital Edition software using an Adobe ID – this allows you to transfer to an eReader and use eBooks on multiple computers; if you bypass this step you will not be able to transfer to other devices.

- Plug in your Nook and follow the steps to activate/authenticate your eReader. You must use the same Adobe ID on your device that you used on your computer.

Step 2: Checkout and download eBooks

- Browse the e-book collection by going back to the ‘Marmot OverDrive Digital Collection’ page.
- Once a selection is made click ‘Add to Cart,’ then ‘Proceed to Checkout.’ The item will stay in your cart for 30 minutes.
- Please note that some titles may not be immediately available for checkout. Click ‘Place a hold’. You’ll be notified by email when the title is available for checkout.
- Click ‘Confirm Checkout.’ After checkout is complete, click “download” (1 at a time) for each title. You may checkout up to 5 titles.
- Follow the prompts to open or save the book.

Step 3: Transfer to your device

- If you’ve downloaded Adobe Digital Editions successfully, it will automatically open after you’ve click ‘Download.’
- With Adobe Digital Editions open, plug your Nook into your computer. It will appear as an icon on the left hand pane, below the list of bookshelves.
- Click on ‘Library View’ in the upper left corner. Click and drag your book title to the Nook icon. It will copy the document.
- Safely remove your device and you’re ready to read!
- **If your eBook is not immediately visible**, touch the menu icon at the bottom of your nook for My Library. The book you just downloaded should appear under ‘My Documents.’ Scroll down to the title. Touch ‘View item details and options.’ Touch ‘Read’ to begin reading your eBook.

How do I return books early?

- Open Adobe Digital Editions on the computer where you downloaded the eBook.
- Select the ‘Library View’ icon in the upper left corner.
- Under the ‘Bookshelves’ heading, select ‘Borrowed.’
- Click the eBook you want to return.
- Click the ‘Item Options’ arrow (in the upper left corner of the selected eBook). Select ‘Return Borrowed Item.’
- Click ‘Return’ to verify that you want to return the title.
