

APPLICATION FOR BOARD OF TRUSTEES RAMPART LIBRARY DISTRICT

The Rampart Library District Board of Trustees is located in Teller County and was established in 1977 and approved by the Teller County Board of Commissioners. The Library District lines were shaped according to the boundaries of the RE-2 School District.

The Library Board of Trustees is a governing, policy-making Board. The board is responsible for a \$1,000,000 budget, two facilities and the policies for funding and operating these facilities.

The Board meets on the second Tuesday of every month at 5:00 p.m. at the Woodland Park Public Library. (Dates and times are occasionally changed.) Trustees must also commit to attending occasional study sessions, workshops, conferences/events and related meetings.

An applicant to the Board of Trustees must be a registered voter of Teller County RE-2 School District and have lived in the District for at least one year. Besides your time and interest in libraries, the most important qualification is a sincere commitment to provide the best possible library service to the District's residents.

Applicants will be given an opportunity to interview with the Library Board. Interested persons who wish to serve on the Board of Trustees should fill out the attached application and return it to either library.
